

TEMPLATE STATUTES FOR "UNIMA ______"

Model and suggested paragraphs for national centers

(This model has been created to be adapted by National Centers and has been based on the International Statutes of UNIMA. Any national center should adjust this text for local laws and local traditions in their country. A National Center may apply rules of procedure in addition to the statutes. These rules of procedure will describe the function of the center more in detail.

The text in **black** color code is obligatory to include in the statutes of every National Center of UNIMA. The text in **green** color code is suggested but not obligatory to include in the statutes. The text in **blue** color is commentaries from the Statutes Commission.)

PREAMBLE

UNIMA (Union Internationale de la Marionnette) is an international Non-Governmental Organization bringing together people from around the world who contribute to the development of the art of puppetry, with the objective of using this art in the pursuit of human values such as peace and mutual understanding between peoples, regardless of race, political or religious convictions and differences in culture, in accordance with the respect of fundamental human rights, such as defined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights of the United Nations of December 10th, 1948.

§1 - AIMS AND MEANS

The aim of UNIMA is to promote the art of puppetry. This aim can be achieved in the following ways:

- 1. By encouraging contacts and exchanges between puppeteers from all nations and continents, using all possible means of communication;
- 2. By organizing congresses, conferences, festivals, exhibitions and competitions, or by giving UNIMA endorsement;
- 3. By assisting members of the Organization in assuring their democratic, union, financial and legal issues and gender non-discrimination in the framework of their professional activities, notably through recommendations or proposals to the competent authorities;
- 4. By encouraging professional training;

- 6. By keeping alive traditions, as well as encouraging the renewal of puppetry;
- 7. By proposing puppetry as a means for ethical and aesthetic education;
- 8. By participating in the work of international organizations with similar objectives.
- 9. By promoting an art of puppetry concerned with respect for the environment and use of resources that positively affect climate change.

(The General assembly of "UNIMA _____" may add more aims and means to this list if it wants – as long as they do not contradict UNIMA's international Statutes.)

2.2)	UNIMA membership can be individual or collective. Members registered as part of a collective are known
	as associate members.
2.3)	It is "UNIMA" that receives and administrates memberships in "". At least once a
	year the Board of "UNIMA" should submit the list of members to the General Secretariat of
	UNIMA, so that the membership fee of "UNIMA" can be calculated, and the membership
	cards can be produced.
2.4)	"UNIMA" receives memberships from people and organizations of its own nationality or
	from people and/or organizations with permanent residence in "". If, for personal, cultural,
	political or any other kind of reason, a person or an organization that is neither the one of their nationality
	nor residence asks to become a member of "UNIMA", they must submit their request to the
	Executive Committee of UNIMA through the General Secretary. The Executive Committee will give its

 2.5) In the case of rejection of membership by "UNIMA _____", a candidate may appeal to the Executive Committee according to the international statutes.
- 2.6) Persons of exceptional merit in the development of puppetry may be appointed for honorary membership of "UNIMA ______".

2.a) MEMBER'S RIGHTS

Each UNIMA member has the right:

- 1. To receive a membership card;
- 2. To be elected in all the positions of UNIMA according to the UNIMA Rules of Procedure, as long as they have paid their fees in full;
- 3. To benefit from all advantages resulting from membership of UNIMA (international information, participation in international exchanges, professional assistance, scholarships, etc.;
- 4. To attend the Congress and the Council

4.b.1) The Board consists of the President, the Secretary and the Treasurer (It is a minimal proposal. The number of members in the board may be different in different countries. It is important to have enough people to get the work done, but not too many – so it will be difficult to find a time where all can meet.) 4.b.2) The Board directs UNIMA activities in "" between General Assembly 4.b.3) The Board is responsible that the Statutes and Rules of Procedure are respected; 4.b.4) The President represents "UNIMA" in all matters of law, presides over the Board. 4.b.5) The Secretary coordinates the activities of UNIMA, informs the international Executive Committee of these activities and organizes the work of "UNIMA". Every time a "UNIMA" makes a change in the Statutes or Rules of procedure and every time new Internationals Councilors are elected the Secretary must inform the international Executive Committee. The Secretary is responsible for the financial affairs of "UNIMA" together with the Treasurer. Every year before the first of April the Secretary must pay the international membership fee to UNIMA and send the list of members to the international general secretariat, together with a list of members of the Board and Internationals Councilors elected by "UNIMA" together with the Secretary, and keeps the books.
 4.c) THE AUDITING COMMISSION 4.c.1) The Auditing Commission controls "UNIMA
§5 - OFFICIAL NAME, HEAD OFFICE AND LEGAL REPRESENTATION 5.1) The official name of the Organization is "UNIMA". (UNIMA and the name of the country must always be a part of the official name. Other names may also be added to explain in the local language what kind of organization is in question.) 5.2) Regional Centers should use the name UNIMA-(+the name of the region) 5.3) "UNIMA" 's head office is the Secretary's office. 5.3) In matters of law, "UNIMA" is represented by its President.
§6 - OFFICIAL LANGUAGES OF UNIMA The language adopted is "" (Or any language the majority of members use).
(The languages adopted by UNIMA according to international statutes are: French, German, English, Russian and Spanish, as well as the language of the Country in which a Congress, a Council or an Executive Committee's meeting are being held.)
§7 - FINANCES 7.1) "UNIMA" is financed by: 1) Membership fees; 2) Donations, bequests and grants; 3) Different income deriving from its activities.



§8 - DISSOLUTION	
8.1) The decision to dissolve "UNIMA	" is made by the General assembly with a two-thirds
majority.
